## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS

- Parents should regularly check and **sign the almanac**.
- Parents are requested to fill the Personal Memo and return the same to the school within one week of the school re-opening.
- We would request the parents to see that the students keep their text / note books neatly and bring only those books required as per time table.
- Parents are not allowed to meet their children or the teachers, during school hours without the permission of the admin authority.
- Parents are requested to return any object the child brings from the school that does not belong to him / her.
- Parents are asked to spend atleast an hour with the children every day.
- Read the **circulars** and provide genuine responses for the circulars.
- Dress the child as per the instructions in the circulars for celebrations.
- Check the school bag at every morning and evening.
- Parents are advised to send a kerchief, a water bottle and 2 lunch towels daily.
- Wash the socks, lunch towels, water bottle and kerchief daily.
- Don't send the child to school in case of any **medical problem**.
- Inform the school in case of any changes in your **mobile number** and **address**.
- It is compulsory for the parents to attend the **Creator & Pro-Creator meet** (parents-teachers meet) on the specified day without fail.
- Instead of sending chocolates on your child's birthday send healthy foods. Eg: coconut balls, burfi, biscuit etc.
- Write your ward's name and class on every belongings of your child.
- Refer to the school website on regular basis.
- **School fees** and other dues must be paid by the stipulated date.
- Encourage the students to take part in extra and co-curricular activities in the school.
- Avoid sending your children for tuitions. Spend some quality time with them.

## CAB RULES

- Student must be present at the appropriate stop at the specified time; the cab will not wait if the student is late.
- Parents are requested to make sure that an authorized person is at the cab stop till the school cab picks up the children in the morning and when the child gets down in the evening.
- Request for any change in the cab route or stop should be made through a phone call or through a written format addressed to the school management.
- Parents are requested not to give instructions to the bus driver or attender. Complaints should be addressed to the school management only.
- Students must remain seated in the cab. Playing or shouting in the school cab is prohibited.
- Damage to the seats, glass and windows etc., will result in payment of fine.
- The cab facility will be withdrawn for those students who repeatedly misbehave in the cab.
